

Checklist for submitting an article intended for JAMD

(To be applied to all types of contributions with the exception of Editorials, Letters, Viewpoints and Comments)

IN GENERAL

- Is the **title** in Italian and in English?
- Does the **title** comply with the maximum length allowed of 150 characters?
- Have the **surname, name and affiliation of each individual author** been reported?
- Was the **surname, first name and email address of the corresponding author** reported?
- Have the **summary/abstract been included in both Italian and English**?
- Are the **summary/abstract structured** and of the maximum length allowed for the type of article?
- Are there **keywords in Italian and English** in the maximum number indicated for the type of article proposed?

TEXT

- Does the **text** comply with the maximum length allowed for the type of article proposed?
- Is the **text** divided into paragraphs according to the indications provided for the type of article proposed?
- Are **tables and figures** included in the maximum number allowed for the type of article proposed?
- Are the **tables** made in text format?
- Are the **figures** saved in the appropriate format (.tiff or .jpg, high resolution)?
- Are **tables and figures** numbered and cited in the text?
- Are the **tables and figures** each accompanied by its own caption and legend of the abbreviations used?
- Is the original source cited for already published **figures**?
- Are the units of measurement, standard deviation, statistical significance, statistical methods used, etc. indicated for the data in **tables and figures**?
- Is any **conflict of interest** reported at the end of the article?
- Are there, where necessary, **key messages in Italian and English**?
- Are individual **key messages**, where necessary, structured as required and do not exceed the number of words indicated for the type of article?

BIBLIOGRAPHY

- Does the **number of bibliographic citations** conform to the type of article proposed?
- Are **bibliographic entries** correctly referenced in the text of the article in the order of citation?
- Are the **bibliographic entries** reported according to the AMA model?
